

ADMISSION to the PROFESSIONAL TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM for Degree Seeking Students

1. Completion of 24 hours of university coursework at the time of application including:
 - ED 155/Teaching Learning and Leadership
 - ED 285/Educational Psychology
2. Successful passage of one of the following tests:
 - ✓ the CORE Academic Skills Test (writing/162, reading/156/math/150)
 - ✓ an overall score of 22 or better on the ACT
 - ✓ an overall score of 1665 on the SAT
3. Secondary (6-12) and All levels (P-12) students must earn a grade of C or better in each content area course from the approved degree plans of study
4. An overall gpa of 2.75 or better for all completed courses
5. Meet with an academic advisor in order to Declare a Major All ELEMENTARY Students are declared by the University Licensure Officer, Tara Porter
